Coach Jen refers to football as full-contact chess, so you will learn the chess pieces, how they move, and how they combine to make the great game work. "Flag football is one of the fastest-growing sports today. In America, around <u>474,000 young women</u> between the ages of 6 and 17 played flag last year — a massive 63% increase from 2019. The surge in participation led some states to sanction girls' flag as a high school sport in 2023, and we will see women play flag football in the 2028 Summer Olympics in Los Angeles."

Through A Day in the Life, ongoing efforts with GRRRidiron Girls, and unwavering commitment, football legend Dr. Jen Welter continues to widen the doors to football for all women and girls.
